## **Readings: Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March**

### **Philippians 3.17-4.1**

<sup>17</sup> Brothers and sisters,\* join in imitating me, and observe those who live according to the example you have in us. <sup>18</sup>For many live as enemies of the cross of Christ; I have often told you of them, and now I tell you even with tears. <sup>19</sup>Their end is destruction; their god is the belly; and their glory is in their shame; their minds are set on earthly things. <sup>20</sup>But our citizenship\* is in heaven, and it is from there that we are expecting a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>21</sup>He will transform the body of our humiliation\* so that it may be conformed to the body of his glory,\* by the power that also enables him to make all things subject to himself. <sup>41</sup>Therefore, my brothers and sisters,\* whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, my beloved.

### **Luke 13.31-end**

#### **The Lament over Jerusalem**

<sup>31</sup> At that very hour some Pharisees came and said to him, 'Get away from here, for Herod wants to kill you.' <sup>32</sup>He said to them, 'Go and tell that fox for me,\* "Listen, I am casting out demons and performing cures today and tomorrow, and on the third day I finish my work. <sup>33</sup>Yet today, tomorrow, and the next day I must be on my way, because it is impossible for a prophet to be killed away from Jerusalem." <sup>34</sup>Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often have I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing! <sup>35</sup>See, your house is left to you. And I tell you, you will not see me until the time comes when\* you say, "Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord." '

**Lent 2019 - "Dust that dreams of glory".** A journey from Ash Wednesday, through the 5 weeks of Lent, the days of Holy Week, to the joy of Easter Sunday. Throughout Lent the course continues at 8pm on a Tuesday evening in Benenden at the Memorial Hall and is repeated again at 7.30pm on a Wednesday evening in Sandhurst at the Mission Church. Once we reach Holy Week there is a service every day, leading us to the celebrations of Easter Sunday. Please pick up a leaflet with all the details.
