'Raising Faith' – Conference at St Mary's Church, Goudhurst Saturday 29th June 2019 from 9.30am to 4.15pm


This conference is aimed at church leaders, youth workers, parents, grandparents, teachers - everyone with a concern for the future faith of our children and young people.
