# Our Worship: Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> March Mothering Sunday

**Collect:** God of compassion, whose Son Jesus Christ, the child of Mary, shared the life of a home in Nazareth, and on the cross drew the whole human family to himself: strengthen us in our daily living that in joy and in sorrow we may know the power of your presence to bind together and to heal; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

In light of the Government guidance around non-essential contact, the Archbishops of Canterbury and York have issued advice that public worship is <a href="suspended">suspended</a> until further notice.

Churches should be open where possible but with no public worship services taking place.

All regular and weekly use of all three churches in the Benefice of Benenden & Sandhurst has been suspended.

#### Colossians 3.12-17

<sup>12</sup> As God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. <sup>13</sup>Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. <sup>14</sup>Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. <sup>15</sup>And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in the one body. And be thankful. <sup>16</sup>Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admonish one another in all wisdom; and with gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God. <sup>17</sup>And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

### **Benefice Worship during Covid-19 service suspensions**

On Sundays Revd David Commander will conduct Communion in the two parishes, using the 'Early Morning Communion' sheet at St George's and the 1946 BCP Communion service at Sandhurst Mission Church. Revd David will take the bread and wine on behalf of us all.

Should anyone wish to attend the Daily Prayer or Communion in person, they can; provided they hand-sanitise, and they maintain "safe distancing". There will be notices to this effect on the church doors. All door handles will have been sanitised. No "material" will be handed out; the priest will lead everything. On a Sunday, if people attend, Revd David will offer a short reflection on the reading(s). This will not be an "act of public worship", but a time of corporate prayer which anyone can join in with either remotely or in person.

Revd David is looking at how the above might be recorded and live streamed; or at least recorded and made available We are also looking at making resources, or links to on-line resources, available on our websites.
